## WHITE WINES

**Cattarato-Chardonnay, Lupo Nero Bianco Sicily** £13.95 £3.00 £3.50 £5.00

The warmth of the Sicilian sun is reflected in the ripe citrus and grilled almond flavours of Lupo Nero Bianca. Crisp, lively and refreshing.

**Pinot Grigio del Veneto, Rocca Estate 2010** £15.95 £3.30 £3.90 £5.95

Straw yellow with an attractive bouquet of orange blossom and lightly spiced herby fruit. Pure and refreshing, this great Pinot Grigio offers crisp, mouthwatering flavours of citrus, apple and white pears.

**Cortese 'Colle dei Tigli', Lenotti Estate 2010** £17.95

Terrific wine at this level. Made on an ancient hill (Colle) covered with lime trees (Tigli), 300m high on the eastern shores of Lake Garda. Light straw-yellow, fruity intense aroma, with hints of peach and apple with a delicate bouquet of flowers.

**Hidden Bay, Marlborough New Zealand** £19.95 £3.95 £4.95 £6.95

This is a single estate Sauvignon is soft and suave in the mouth with a zesty acidity and a wash of green apples, tropical minerality and ripe melon

**Petit Chablis, Domaine Tremblay, Burgundy** £20.95

Very well made, it expresses the personality of the vineyard with its pale-yellow colour and sparkling brilliance. Superb, refreshing, clean dry white wine from the medal winning producer Gerard Tremblay.

**Sancerre, Domaine Paul Doucet, Loire Valley 2010** £21.95

Intense and flowery on the nose with hints of accacia and lime blossom with tropical fruit notes. The subtle taste confirms the bouquet and offers a great balance of freshness and flavour. The Doucet family wine growing and wine making expertise has been dedicated to producing fine Sancerre since 1975.

**Bricco dei Guazzi Gavi di Gavi DOCG 2010** £23.95

One of Italy's most prestigious white wines, this is a wonderfully light white wine with rich chalky mineral and almond notes

Hailing from the deep south of Italy Lupo Nero rosso offers generous quantities of dark berry fruit with a ripeness that only the warmth of Mediterranean sun can bring.

<b>Tempranillo, Vega robe2010</b>	<b>£14.95</b>	<b>£3.20</b>	<b>£3.70</b>	<b>£5.10</b>
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The Tempranillo for this youthful and fruity red wine come from the old wine region of Castilla. Elegant nuances of oak on the nose thanks to 6 months ageing in oak barrels. A medium bodied, fruit driven wine.

<b>Primitivo Salento, Rocca estate 2009</b>	<b>£15.95</b>
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It has an intense ruby red colour with violet hints . The flavour is dry, solid and velvety. The perfume is intense, characteristic of ripened grape with scent of cherry.

<b>Rioja Crianza 'Blason de Esquide', Castillo de fuenmayor 2007</b>	<b>£17.95</b>
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A typical Rioja Crianza obtained from 75% Tempranillo, 20% Garnacha and 5% Graciano grapes. Aged for one year in American oak casks, and a further six months in bottles. This results in a rich ruby red colour, a gentle aroma, and a long finish, which is pleasing to the mouth.

<b>Nero d'Avola Sicilia, Baglio Sicano 2009</b>	<b>£18.95</b>
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Nero d'Avola is a grape variety native to Sicily. Pleasant nose with scents of ripe red fruits, tobacco and liquorice. It has soft tannins and a good persistence. Fantastic value for money!

<b>Chianti Superior Riserva, Valdarno Estate 2008</b>	<b>£20.95</b>
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Valdarno Chianti Superiore is a typical Tuscan production that unites tradition and experience. The grapes are harvested by hand and the wine produced is aged in casks for a minimum of 24 months. A bright ruby-red colour with a persistent nose of flowery and fruity aromas. Dry and fresh with mild tannins this wine is perfect with food...or not.

<b>Tenuta Rocca Cabernet-Barbera, Langhe Rosso DOC 2007</b>	<b>£21.95</b>
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**Two years of barrique ageing make this a wine of phenomenal body and length. Black cherry, cassis and notes of dark chocolate stand alongside rich, finely-integrated tannins and a smooth, warming body.**

<b>Bricco dei Guazzi Barbera d'Asti DOC 2007</b>	<b>£22.95</b>
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Asti is a small town within Monferrato in Piemonte, and is one of the best Barbera-producing regions. This example has aromas of ripe red fruits, particularly red cherries, and it is full-bodied with soft, silky tannins. It has delicate hints of fruit on the finish, and a subtle note of vanilla. Perfect with red meat, game and aged cheeses.

<b>Pian della Querci Rosso di Montalciano, 2006</b>	<b>£23.95</b>
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A stunning example of Brunello's "Little brother", offering excellent value. Made from pure Sangiovese, this 2006 from the small estate of Pian delle Querci it has round, full mouthfeel with soft tannins and mature strawberry fruit

<b>Malbec Reserva , Terrazas de los Andes, Argentina</b>	<b>£25</b>
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Aromas are powerful and complex with notes of red fruits such as raspberry, red currant and plum, with vanilla and caramel from aging in oak. This wine's meatiness and intense, rich flavour give it some serious character, as well as a lively, memorable personality.
